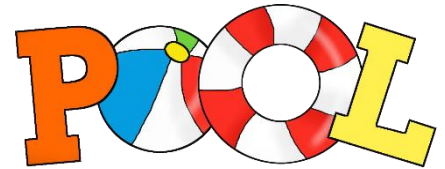

1. Patrons (AGES 2 & OVER) entering the pool must present a current 2018 season pool I.D. when entering the pool or if paying at the door, a wristband must be purchased & the wristband must be worn at all times.
2. Rules apply to all patrons, whether you hold a 2018 season pool pass or paying at the door for a wristband.
3. Wristbands are only good for one session. We have two sessions a day: Day Swim (1-4 p.m.) & Night Swim (5-8 p.m.). The pool is closed from 4-5 p.m. Each session is a separate fee.
4. Patrons paying to receive a wristband are required to wear the wristband the entire time you are in the pool.
5. A patron may not leave with a wristband & re-enter later. Once you leave, you are not permitted to come back unless you pay for another wristband. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS ON WRISTBANDS FOR ANY REASON! Patrons enter the pool at your discretion!
7. A lost/stolen pass is the responsibility of the patron. This will result in a replacement pass with a fee of \$15.00 to be paid in the office during regular business hours. Patrons may not enter until the pass is replaced.
8. Children ages 5 & under must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older in which the adult will be swimming with the child at all times.
9. Children ages 6 to 10 years old must be accompanied by a responsible adult age 16 years or older in which the 16 year old will be responsible to watch the child in & out of the pool at all times.
10. Children ages 3 & under are required to wear a swim diaper. A lifeguard or staff member will approach a parent if a child is not wearing a swim diaper & in the pool. The parent will have the opportunity to purchase a swim diaper from the recreation center for \$3.00 or leave the pool deck all together.
11. Pools will close due to inclement weather or the temperature falls to 68° or lower. There are NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS FOR INCLEMENT WEATHER.
12. Patrons entering the pool must have a lined bathing suit. NO gym shorts, cut-offs, basketball shorts, workout clothing or street clothing allowed. This includes tops also. The BRD Staff has the right to decide what is appropriate swim wear. A patron will have to leave the pool deck & exit from the building if found abusing this rule. NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS WILL BE AWARDED!
13. **NO STREET SHOES ALLOWED ON POOL DECK AT ANY TIME..**
14. **Patrons are required to take a shower before exiting the locker rooms to swim. Patrons should remove all suntan oils, lotions, hair products & other contaminants before entering the pool. A shower is required after the use of the bathrooms! This is for the health & safety for our patrons.**
15. All personal items such as clothing & street shoes should be locked in a locker. Patrons must bring their own locks for the lockers! Valuable items should be left at home or in your car. The BRD is not responsible for lost or stolen items from the locker rooms or pool deck area. Use of the lockers is AT YOUR OWN RISK!
16. Lawn chairs and baby strollers may be brought onto the pool deck. The pool manager shall be the sole judge of what items are allowed on the pool deck area.
17. **No vending or outside food/beverages, alcohol, coolers, grills or radios permitted! Pavak Pool has a concession stand with many choices of food & beverages that can be purchased at reasonable prices. Food & beverages are to be consumed in the concession area. Patrons caught bringing in food/beverages, will be asked to leave the pool. If found bringing food into the pool area from the concession stand, you will be asked once to take it to the concession area & then if found abusing the rule, asked to leave.**
18. Clear plastic water bottles & baby bottles are the only items that will be allowed in the pool area.
19. THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING ON THE GROUNDS OF THE BERWYN RECREATION DEPARTMENT. If you need to smoke, you must leave the facility. If you are a guest wearing a wristband, there is NO RE-ENTR!
20. Conduct within the pool facility must be such that safety for the patrons is not jeopardized. Lifeguards will uphold general rules set forth by the City of Berwyn Recreation Department Director & Aquatic Staff. If patrons are acting out in such behavior inappropriate or unsafe that it could do harm to oneself or other patrons, the lifeguard staff has the right to act upon to secure safety within the area. Patrons unable to follow the rules will be ejected. Overt misconduct will result in the loss of swimming privileges for part or all of the season without a refund. When children are found running, swearing or fighting, they will be told to sit out of the pool by the lifeguard chair for a time or asked to leave the pool altogether.
