- It is the duty of the manager and coach to be in control of their players at all times in order to prevent any unsportsmanlike act toward opponents, officials & spectators.
- Manager and coach are expected to comply wholeheartedly with the intent & spirit of the rules. The deliberate teaching of players to violate the rules is indefensible.
- Manager & Coach should teach their players to respect the dignity of the game, officials, opponent, & the institutions which they represent.
- Manager & Coach should emphasize the fact that their base coaches must confine their remarks to their own teammates & not ride the opposing players.
- Manager & Coach should refrain from any personal action that might arouse players or spectators to unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Managers & Coach should expect from the umpires courteous and dignified attitude toward players and themselves.
- Alcoholic beverages or use of any controlled substances by manager, coaching staff and participants in the program, during a game or practice is strictly prohibited and will result in dismissal from the baseball program! This rule also includes being inebriated prior to a game or practice.
- Smoking in the dugout, while coaching or in the stands is prohibited!
- Profanity by Manager, coaching staff, players and fans will not be tolerated. Fans will be asked to leave the area. Managers, coaching staff & players will be warned and then possible suspension.
- The above Code of Ethics will be solely up to the discretion of the acting umpire.
- Players must be in uniform in order to play in a game.

RULES OF CONDUCT

1. The ejection of manager or coach from a ball game for any reason shall result in their being suspended from his team's next game. Ejected manager or coach will not be allowed in bleachers or within park property. Manager of team being played next must also be notified.
2. Second ejection in the same season will result in immediate dismissal from program.
3. Any fight involving umpires, manager, coaches, players or other officially rostered adults on our playing field, shall result in immediate dismissal from the program. Ejection of players from a game: It will be up to the manager to remove said player from the game in a quiet and orderly fashion. By doing this we hope to remove some of the fanfare and crowd excitement that accompanies a player ejection. Both manager and the umpire need to be the only ones who even know of the player ejection. The less attention brought up by an ejection of a player the better control of the game. Penalty for ejection of a player is a one game suspension from play from the team's next game. Player must attend the game and sit the bench.

EQUIPMENT

Metal cleats are NOT PERMITTED!

The return of equipment must be returned on designated date provided by the Berwyn Recreation Center.

PLAYING RULES

1. Continuous batting order in Mustang & Bronco will be in play.
2. In the Mustang division, an inning will conclude once a team has batted through the batting order or three (3) outs, whichever occurs first (Ten players is considered batting through the order).
3. In the event a player is disrespectful, demonstrates inappropriate behavior, or misses a majority of the teams' practices and games without a valid excuse, a manager may suspend or reduce the players playing time for one (1) game providing he/she follows these procedures:
 - Contacts the parent and discusses the problem.
 - Submits in writing the cause for suspension to the Program Supervisor.
 - Receives a letter of approval from the Program Supervisor.
4. In the Mustang Division, per Pony Baseball rules, runners may steal bases, but shall not leave the base they are occupying until the pitched ball has reached or passed the catcher (NO LEAD-OFFS). Third base stops the play. Runners may advance to home plate only when the ball is put into play by the batter.
5. Players will be required to avoid contact into other players while a play is being made. If a player does not avoid contact, they will be called out (umpires judgment & discretion).
6. There is NO dropped third strike in Mustang Division.
7. Mustang & Bronco Division teams must field at least eight (8) players or game will be forfeited.
8. Any rainout or suspended games will be made up by the Berwyn Recreation Program Supervisor only. Games will not be switched for any other reason; we will stick to the schedule posted. Managers are responsible for confirming rescheduled game dates and times by checking the bulletin board at the concession stand at Baseball Alley or by calling the rainout phone number (708) 749-6532. Please DO NOT LEAVE MESSAGES ON THE RAINOUT LINE!
